

Choose 3 of your spellings this week and put them into a sentence. Make your sentence as exciting as you can. Maybe include some adjectives or adverbs!	Which Katie Morag story is your favourite? Write a review of your favourite story and explain why it is your favourite making references to the story.	Go on a winter walk maybe to the woods or the park and take pictures of signs of winter (frost, ice, berries, bird's nests, snow, mist, icicles, etc). Present your findings (poster, booklet, collage)	When (or if) it snows, build a snow sculpture. Take a picture and bring to school. The best sculpture wins a prize!	Create a map of your street. You can either draw one, or make a model. Label the physical and human features on your map.	Design an instrument to measure a type of weather (rain, wind, snow, ice). Test your design out and record your findings. When you have finished, bring in your instrument to share with the class.
Choose 3 of your spellings this week that you do not know the meaning of and use a dictionary (with the help of an adult) to find out what they mean.	Practise your 2 times tables, i.e 1 x 2 is 2, 2 x 2 is 4. Be ready to recite to the rest of the class. Can you make actions to go with it?	Write an acrostic poem using a winter word of your choice.	Make a simple board game for you to play with a friend at school. The board game has to include the four operations (add, subtract, multiply and divide).	Research a place you have been to or would like to go to in the UK. Make a tourist leaflet for that place. Include information about the place and why it is an interesting place to visit. Maybe you have already been there on holiday!	Create an "Easter Garden" to remember when Jesus died on the cross and rose again. Be as creative as you like!



Children need to choose **one activity** from the grid **every other week**. Once they have completed an activity they can colour in the jigsaw piece with the corresponding colour for that column. Therefore, by the end of the Spring Term, they should have completed 1 activity from each column and they will have a completed jigsaw puzzle.
