Dear Parents

But in the following week towards the Easter holidays, if you can, please remember also to play board games together, learn about different insects in the garden, read books, bake cakes, teach the children how to garden, how to sew, learn new skills, **be a family**. It is vital that you give yourselves the space and time to digest the sudden changes that have taken place and particularly for the children, who are processing what has happened.
