- Choose a jungle animal that does not appear in the book. Write a poem to go your chosen animal as an extra page for the book. Follow the format of the other poems in the book for each animal. Try to find some words that rhyme (use the attached template to write and draw a picture)
- Choose an animal in the book and write an acrostic poem

Year 1: Split Digraph Hunt - Look through the book "Rumble in the Jungle". Can you find all the split digraphs - u\_e, a\_e, e\_e, i\_e and o\_e. Make a list under each one of all the words you can find.


Year 2: Find out about contractions. List all the contractions in the story (eg; can't, it's). Write them out as two words. Can you think of any of your own contractions?


## Rumble in the Jungle!

## Geography

## Maths

Create a table of all the animals in the story. Ask your family and friends (call them, facetime them, skype them or even have a house party) and make a tally of their favourite animal. Represent your findings in a bar chart. What was the most popular animal? What was the least favourite? What is the difference between the most and least favourite?



## Science

Choose a jungle animal from the story and research it. Some ideas to think about - where does it live in the jungle? What does it eat? How does it move? How has its body adapted to live in the jungle? How many are left on the planet?

List all the animals in the story and sort into categories "herbivores", "carnivores" and "omnivores". Write a description for the above categories.
