Sports at School

I'm sure we've got some potential Olympians in our school and one focus for this year is to encourage greater participation in sports. In the last few years we've used Team Theme as a coaching company to help deliver sports at school. For this year, I have employed a sports coach onto our staff to work alongside our teachers to improve sports at school. His name is Mr Alex Cotter and he also coaches at two other schools in the area. He will be in on Thursdays to run PE sessions with all the classes and an after school sports club. He will also be arranging inter school competitions in various sports and organising special sporting events. We want to get as many children as possible to take part in sporting events and competitions.

Reminders

- 1) Due to 2 children in school having a serious Nut allergy, we would request all parents not to allow any nuts in packed lunches or snacks.
- School Dinners Payment can be made in cash/cheque (payable to Caterlink Ltd) to Mrs Mac -£2.05 per day. Please note that dinners should be paid for in advance or on the day (before school). Any changes to/from school dinners require 2 weeks notice. A copy of the menu will be in book bags today.
- 3) Please do not park around the tree in the car park but keep the route clear for parents to come down the lane and turn round. Whilst the field is dry the gates will be opened to allow more parking.
- 4) Please do not allow any children to play on the playground equipment at the end of the day.
- 5) Please make sure your children have their PE kit in school every day.
- 6) All children should have a named water bottle (clear plastic) in school every day.
- 7) Children are only allowed to wear stud earrings which must always be removed for PE and swimming. No other jewellery (including bracelets) is allowed.

Outdoor Learning

At the end of last term the teachers had In-Service training on outdoor learning. I think all the teachers had fun (building structures; lighting fires; orienteering and tying ourselves up in knots) and were very inspired. We believe there is so much creative learning and enjoyment in outdoor activities so all classes will be holding regular outdoor learning sessions. We may need your help in terms of providing wellies and suitable clothing for your child on those activity days; and we may need assistance in resourcing some of the activities.

Meet the teachers

Next week we will be holding "meet the teacher" sessions when parents are invited to listen to your child's teacher about what and how the children will be learning. Please see the dates below. These will be from 2.45 – 3.15pm. Mrs Winchester has already held this session for Venus class in July. If you need to speak to the class teacher about any specific concerns, please let Mrs Mac know and we will arrange it. There will also be parent consultations in October (earlier than previous years) so we can let you know how your child has settled into the new school year.

Smart Uniforms

We will be actively encouraging them to wear correct uniform; look smart and would be grateful if you could also encourage your child and praise them when they come out of school looking smart with ALL their uniform.
