Reading: Northern Lights

Analyse chapters and answer comprehension questions about what has been read.

We will be describing and developing our own characters and plot based upon the text. We will then be writing extended narratives that include diary entries.

GPS

Science – Forces

- Investigate how levers and pulleys work.

Computing – Text Adventures

This term we will be finding out about, planning and making a ‘text adventure’. We will move on to map-based text adventures and code our own adventure.

Maths – ratio and proportion

- Understand, calculate and solve problems involving ratio.
- Apply knowledge of ratio and proportion to problems of increasing complexity and explain reasoning and thinking.
- Use algebraic representation to illustrate relationships and patterns.
- Use algebra to prove relationships and patterns.

Year 6 will spend some time revising each topic in preparation for the SATs.

History – Were the Romans really rotten?

This term we will be finishing our topic on the Romans and conclude: Romans were really rotten?

- Developing an understanding of what Britain was like before the Romans.
- Study Boudicca’s rebellion Battle of Colchester
- Investigate Roman legacy.

Crime and Punishment

We will then move on to Crime and Punishment where we will be testing fingerprints, investigate crime scenes and use problem solving skills to find out who did it. We will also look at crime and punishment through the ages and explore how it has changed.

We will be looking at the text of Isaiah 53, John 19 and key concepts Massiah, Sacrifice and Salvation and make clear links between them.
