We are proud to announce that our Key Stage 2 pupil progress measures for 2018 were the top of all schools in the Ashford district for Reading and Maths and second in Writing. Our combined expected attainment in all subjects was also number one of all schools in the Ashford district. Overall we rated 17 out of 420 primary schools in Kent, for combined progress. I am extremely proud of all of our pupils and team!
