### Why does Easter matter to Christians?

This term we have been looking at the above question. Watch the suggested videos and discuss and learn:

### PE - Bat and Ball Skills

Continue to practise your bat and ball skills.

- Holding a racket (like a hand shake)
- Balancing a ball on the racket
- Hitting a ball from a racket
- Practise catching and throwing with a partner

## Maths

Visit "youtube" and search Jack Hartmann. Use these videos to practise daily counting.

Practise the four operations (add, subtract, multiplication and division) by rolling 2 dice and making up your own number sentences. For example, if you roll a 6 and 2 you could do

- $6 + 2 =$
- $6 - 2 =$
- 6 lots of 2 =
- 6 shared between 2 =

\*\* Y2s: Roll the dice twice so you end up with two sets of numbers to add and subtract

## Fractions

## Time

Keep practising tell the time.

Y2s only - Start to learn 5 minute interval time and digital clock

## Literacy

To keep up your writing skills, write a diary entry every day (when possible) and tell me what you have been doing. Remember your targets:-

Y1: Finger spaces, full stops, capital letters, writing on the line, correct letter formation, some describing words

Y2: Finger spaces, a range of punctuation (! , . ? ' ), expanded noun phrases (big, red apple), join some letters together, used conjunctions (because, but, and, so)

Y1s: Practise your flashcard phonic sounds every day!
