HOME SCHOOLING DURING SELF-ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE

Thank you to the many of you who have communicated with us daily to let us know that your child needs to self-isolate or quarantine as part of the Government's Coronavirus regulations. We realise that this can be a difficult situation for both you and your child; they miss lessons, the routine of coming to school and seeing their friends and teachers.

In order to help your child keep up with their schoolwork if they are off school, we will be posting work on Tapestry (Year R, Year 1 and 2) and Seesaw (Years 3,4,5 and 6).

From **Monday 19th October**, a selection of generic tasks for learning will be posted online. These will be labelled 'Covid Learning tasks A-E'. These tasks are only for completion when children are in isolation, quarantine or waiting for test results.

One task per subject should be completed on the **first day** of any period of absence.

If your child is off school for longer than an initial day, work will be posted to your child's account, relating to the learning they have missed in class, to allow them to "catch up", before their return to school.

DAY 1 of absence	Complete one of generic Covid Learning tasks A-E per subject
DAY 2 of absence (or beyond)	Learning missed from lessons taught in class will be posted for your child to complete


Should a 'bubble', or group of children, need to isolate for a significant period of time, full curriculum provision will commence on these platforms and parents will be notified by email and text to say that work is 'live'. Tasks will be updated daily by the teachers and feedback will be given to the children.

Please note that work should only be completed if your child is well and able to do so.

If you have not yet received a login for Tapestry or Seesaw, or you do not have access to a computer/tablet at home, please notify me as soon as possible, so that alternative arrangements can be made.

For parents using Tapestry please note that you will need to log into to Tapestry using the desktop site (<https://tapestryjournal.com/>) to be able to access the attached documents to support your child's learning. Your log in details will be the same as those you use to access the app version of Tapestry. You can still use a tablet to do this.
