Christmas play/Church service

The Jupiter class Christmas play is today – the hall doors will open at 6.10pm, with the play due to start at 6.30pm. We can only allow 2 adults per family in the hall and all adults should wear a mask please (unless exempt).

The Church service is tomorrow (Thursday) and starts at 9am – all children to be taken straight to Church. Please note that Mrs. Henshaw is very kindly allowing parents to park in the yard of Parsonage Farm (TN25 5LR) which is around the corner, just past the Church, as you head towards Stowting. Mrs. Henshaw would very much appreciate parents parking in her yard, as too many cars parked on the road causes problems for any tractors...etc trying to get through. We would also ask that no more than two adults per family attend the service – again, please do wear masks (unless exempt).

Due to the Church service being on the last day of term, I will have to ask all children to wear school uniform on the last day of term.

COVID

We have <u>not</u> had a positive Covid case reported in school since the weekend of 4th December. My sincere thanks to all parents for obtaining a PCR test immediately when their child had symptoms – I do believe this has enabled us to 'catch' and isolate the Covid cases very early. I do hope we can reach the end of term without any further cases, although I do realise there are plenty of children still suffering with the usual winter colds/coughs ...etc. Let's hope everyone is better in time for Christmas.

I have been advised that, even if a child has had Covid, should they then display Covid symptoms again, they must obtain a further PCR test.
