
Alexandra's Story

Alexandra, a former pupil of Brabourne, was diagnosed in March 2022 with Metastatic Stage IV "Desmoplastic Small Round Cell Tumour (DSRCT)", an extremely rare and aggressive cancer primarily seen in children and young adults. Alexandra's parents are exploring experimental treatments in the United States targeting this particular cancer. Given its rarity, these may be the only treatments available to give Alexandra a fighting chance. Unfortunately, there is not much financial support within the medical community for research and treatment for this particular cancer and Alexandra's family will have to meet the costs of potentially lifesaving treatment from their own resources. Class News


