	What have we been learning about at school?	What could you do to support at home?
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week in phonics we have looked at the digraph or as in born and ar as in car. We have also looked at the digraph oo and learnt that this can make two different sounds. It can make the long oo sound as in moon or the short oo sound as in book. We have also learnt the tricky word my We have been continued to practise writing tricky words the, no, go, to and I. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise using the digraphs oo/oo, or and ar to make words. You could make moon, zoom, boom, pool, book, cook, hood, wood, corn, fort, sort, car, barn, star. Practise the tricky words my. Can you remember how to write the tricky word I and to.
Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we have continued to look at the Naughty Bus story. We loved sharing the photos uploaded on to Tapestry for this (not sure who had more fun; children or their parents!) and there were so many fantastic ideas. Thank you. We also looked at some of the things Naughty Bus had been doing in school like filling the kitchen sink with too many bubbles and driving down Mrs Parry's computer monitor. He even snuck into Mr Stapley's office. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go on a bus (or this could be a half term treat). Talk about the journey and how the bus driver knows when to stop to let the passengers on or off.
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Maths this week we have continued to look at the compositions of numbers to 5 and are getting really good at saying number sentences and using the vocabulary plus/add and equals We have also looked how to make a simple tally to 5 to record a score. We recorded how many beanbags out of 5 had landed in the hoop using a tally. We have also been comparing groups of objects and sharing out objects fairly. We have learnt the vocabulary fair, equal, unfair, unequal. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collect 5 balls (or you could use 5 pairs of socks made into balls). Throw them into a hoop or bucket. Can you remember how to make a tally to record how many landed in the bucket? Challenge a family member to a game and record their score too. Who scored the most? How can you tell?
Topic Terrific Transport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we have enjoyed travelling and gaining confidence in using the large apparatus with coach Harry. We have also been on a trip to the moon in Cosmic Kids Yoga. We enjoyed painting our Naughty Busses. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Next week we will hopefully be making boats and rockets.
