

 Key Concept Question: What qualities make a successful Monarch?

Core Texts

If All the World Were..... This beautiful story tells the love that one little girl has for her ageing granddad. They spend each season having fun together but she knows he is not well. One day he isn't there anymore, but the little girl finds evidence of their happy times together.



The Queen's Hat: This story is about the Queen losing her favourite hat. It flies off her head so her soldiers chase after it. It flies around all of the London attractions and famous landmarks where it eventually lands on a baby's head outside Kensington Palace.

How can family history, such as our own and Queen Elizabeth II's, be represented?

Who is King Richard III and how do we know about him?

What are the differences and similarities of Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth I?
