Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In phonics we have now reached the end of learning the level 3 sounds. This week we have been using our knowledge of all the level 3 digraphs and trigraphs to read and write captions. Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we have focussed on the story of Alan’s Big Scary Teeth In Drawing Club we learnt some new WOW words – these are razor sharp, gnashing, gigantic, petrifying, ashamed and dozing We designed n alligator with razor sharp teeth. 	
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Maths this week we have been consolidating our understanding of measure. We have continued to explore length and height and have ordered animals of different size. 	
Topic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we learnt about the work of David Attenborough. We also talked about some endangered animals and why they are vulnerable. We learnt some things that we can do to help make a difference to our planet and protect it for the animals that live on it; such as planting new trees and flowers, recycling our rubbish and saving energy

This week we have also been finding out more about the Easter story and the significance of the cross. We made Easter gardens, Easter cards, Easter cakes and baskets.
