Phonics	<ul> <li>This week we have been continuing to look at words with three adjacent consonants such as in the words drinks and bumps.</li> <li>We have been listening carefully for each of the three sounds that make the blend.</li> <li>We have been learning to spell the tricky words they, all and are</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>I have included a sheet with level 4 words. Read the words and cut and stick the pictures to match.</li> </ul>
Literacy	<ul> <li>This week continued to looking at our core text; Billy's Bucket. We wrote about the magical creatures we could see in our buckets and tried to add feelings words to our sentences.</li> <li>In Drawing Club we looked at the story Someone Swallowed Stanley. Stanley is a plastic bag who ends up in the sea. The creatures think he's a jellyfish and try to eat him. We learnt the words tentacles, gulped, spluttered, pollution, vast and buoyant.</li> <li>We designed our own Stanley and made him get eaten by a new predator. We then recycled Stanley and turned him into something new.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Teach a grown up at home the new words you have learnt in Drawing Club this week.</li> </ul>
Maths	<ul> <li>In Maths this week we have continued to consolidate numbers to 20.</li> <li>We have been finding missing numbers in a sequence.</li> <li>We used numicon to make the teen numbers, using a tens piece and extra ones.</li> <li>We have been counting on and back from a given teen number.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Practise counting on from a given number. E.g I have 11 peas already, continue counting the rest 12-13-14 etc.</li> </ul>
Topic Under the Sea.	<ul> <li>After reading the story Someone Swallowed Stanley, we recycled some plastic bags, bubble wrap and plastic packaging by cutting them into strips and attaching them to some paper cups to create jelly fish.</li> <li>This week has been international week so to link back to our Japanese artist Katsushika Hokusai, from last week, we tasted different bread from around the world and then made some Japanese Milk Bread. We also made some traditional Italian margarita pizzas, jelly and ice cream. It was lots of fun tasting all the foods.</li> <li>This week has also been very exciting as our 3 eggs hatched on Monday. Unfortunately, one didn't make it but we now have two happy and healthy little ducklings who we are really enjoying taking care of for the next few weeks. We have had lots of cuddles with them and given them their first swimming lesson.</li> </ul>	• Talk about recycling at home with your child. Why is it important that we recycle and re-ruse?
