2022/2023 Measuring the Impact of Sports Funding

- 100% of pupils participated in quality coaching during the school week.
- All pupils took part in at least one intra-school active competition and over two thirds of KS2 pupils took part in inter school competitions. All EY/KS1 pupils took part in at least one inter competition.
- Two thirds of pupils in Years 1-6 to took part in an after-school sports club.
- 100% of pupils took part in physical activity during Outdoor Adventurous Activities with Sports Giants and sport themed weeks.
- 100% of pupils were inspired by more unusual sports which they may not otherwise have had the opportunity to access, such as curling or wheel chair basketball.
- 10 additional hours of extra quality coaching and training was offered in preparation for matches/competitions.
- 100% of pupils learnt about making healthy mental and physical health choices.
- The school maintained its Gold Mark Sports Award for 2022/2023.
- Purchasing of sports equipment allowed for pupils to become more active at playtime.
- All KS2 pupils took part in additional Adventurous Activities as part of residential.
- Specialist sports coaches in PE, dance, hockey, athletics and AOL allowed all pupils the opportunity to expert teaching across all areas of PE.
