Phonics	<ul> <li>This week we have reviewed our sounds (s,a,t,p,i n,m,d,g,o,c,k) and practiced our blending and segmenting skills. This is continuing to improve and we are getting quicker at robot talking.</li> <li>We also learnt the phoneme 'ck' as in duck. We have learnt that this is a digraph which is when two letters join together to make one sound.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Your child has brought home a set of grapheme (letter) cards. Please cut them up and use them to practise at home. Keep them in the small zipped wallet. There is also a sound mat with phonemes highlighted which your child needs to work on. If your child knows them all, please practise blending using the sound cards.</li> <li>Continue to practise making words for your child to blend using the phonemes we have learnt - e.g. got, dog, on, pot, gas, tag, duck etc.</li> </ul>
Literacy	<ul> <li>This week we looked at some different stories based on seasons and Autumn and shared our experiences of each. We read 'Leaf Man', 'After the Storm' and 'Seasons' which are just a few.</li> <li>We learnt the word 'seasons'.</li> </ul>	Talk about the cycle of the seasons – can your child remember the 4 different seasons in order and talk about the differences?
