Literacy	 Our focus text is 'Aaaarrgghh! Spider! By Lydia Monks with WOW vocabulary – weaving, sparkly, magnificent, terrifying, petrified. The children found this book very amusing and it helped to generate lots of interesting discussion. The children have continued to write their own clues to guess the minibeast. Children have been applying their Level 3 phonic knowledge in their writing. We have also started writing the inserts for our Easter cards. 	 Can you remember what each of the 'wow' words mean and answer some of the questions below? Do you think the spider might be better off living outside? Would it be less lonely there? What makes you think this? Why do people keep pets? What makes a good pet? Do you think a spider would make a good pet? Why, or why not? What do you think might make people afraid of spiders? Do you think people should be afraid of all spiders? Why or why not? Do you think it is a bad thing to feel afraid? What are you afraid of? Maybe you talk about your fears as a family, discussing why you have these fears and different ways of managing or coping with your fears.
Maths	 This week in maths we have been exploring bonds to 10 (3 parts). We have also been finding and making doubles to 10 and revisiting odd and even numbers. We compared doubles and not doubles by sorting them into hoops and found matching Numicon to show doubles too. We noticed that all of all our double numbers are even 2,4,6,8,10 and the other numbers are odd 1,3,5,7,9 We used the Numicon to play games such as standing up if we have an odd number and finding our matching double. Key vocabulary: number bonds, ten, nine, composition, part, whole, double, odd, even 	 Collect 10 objects. How many different ways can you make 10 making 3 groups? Can you find any matching domino doubles? Can you make doubles using objects? What double have you made? Is it a double or not a double? How do you know? Provide children with numeral cards 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 in a pile. Prompt them to select one numeral and ask them to build the two numbers that make that double. Ask children to talk about the double they have made.

We made our own Easter eggs out our natural materials we collected using card and double-sided tape. We also played hide and seek and continued to work on our bug hotels.
