	What have we been learning about at school?	What could you do to support at home?
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have been practicing our Level 4 reading and writing. We have also focused on making sure we form the majority of our letters with the correct formation. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you practise reading all your level 4 tricky words: said, so, have, like, come, some, were, there, little, one, do, when, out, what. Can you practise writing some of your tricky words: he, she, me, we, be, was, you, they, all, are, my, here
Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Drawing Club we looked at the story 'Someone Swallowed Stanley'. Stanley is a plastic bag who ends up in the sea. The creatures think he's a jellyfish and try to eat him. We learnt the words tentacles, gulped, spluttered, pollution, vast and buoyant. We designed our own Stanley and made him get eaten by a new predator. We then recycled Stanley and turned him into something new. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teach a grown up at home the new words you have learnt in Drawing Club this week. Talk about recycling at home with your child. Why is it important that we recycle and re-use? We have been talking about the damage that some of our rubbish does to the oceans when it ends up in our seas.
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In maths this week we started to visualise, build and map. We enjoyed identifying units of repeating patterns and creating our own pattern rules. We also used our knowledge to explore pattern rules. Key vocabulary: pattern, repeat, rule, same, different, next, before, 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have a go at designing and exploring patterns at home. We have made lots of different patterns at school this week using lots of different colours, shapes, sizes and objects. Anything can be used in a pattern and as long as the pattern has a repeating rule then it will always be a repeating pattern.
Topic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We went on an exciting trip to Wingham Wildlife Park. Some of the highlights was the dinosaur workshops and the playful penguins zooming around the pool! We loved giving our ducklings their first swimming lesson this week. The children have been mesmerised by the ducklings and have enjoyed lots of cuddles. We will continue to look after the ducklings over the next few weeks and watch them grow.
