Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have been practicing our Level 4 reading and writing. Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In maths we have practised visualising, building and mapping. We followed instructions and gave instructions to our classmates using lots of positional language. We had to make sure our instructions were really clear to make sure our arrangements of objects were the same. The children loved engaging in and exploring a variety of exciting activities such as the mud kitchen, creative area, hammocks, and puppet theatre. One of the highlights was using the fire pit to make our own s'mores with marshmallows and biscuits. We have been talking about how to keep safe in the sun. As part of DT we started to make wooden under the sea creatures such as fish and jelly fish. We carefully hammered the nail into the wood, then carefully weaved the colourful wool around the nails to create our desired effect. We will be finishing these off next week. On Thursday the new entrants came to visit us in the afternoon. We showed our school values of responsibility and respect by helping the new children to settle in and find an activity to play with. We have also been reflecting on our year in Venus class as we begin to think about transition into Year 1. We look forward to our 'moving up day' next week where we will get to go into our new classroom and get to know our new teachers even better.
