Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For literacy this week we have been reflecting on our highlights of being in Venus Class.</li> <li>We have been writing about what we enjoy the most, what we are good at, what we are improving and what we are proud of.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Can you talk about your Venus highlights at home? Why did you enjoy those parts the most? What are you proud of and why? What are you getting better at?</li> </ul>
