We have also been budding authors over the last 2 weeks where we have written our own stories based on 'The Last Wolf' and published and illustrated them to create story books. We have been so impressed with how engaged the children have been with this project and what superb writing has been produced.

The children have also completed a Curriculum writing piece in R.E based on retelling the story of the Lost Son. The children were amazing at recalling the details of the story and they wrote their little hearts out!


We are immensely proud of the children completing a fun and successful first term.




